The PZC-I curb clamp is a hydraulic jaw grip device designed for lifting and laying sidewalk curbs with ease and safety. Powered by a double-acting hydraulic cylinder, the clamp is equipped with a safety valve to prevent load loss in case of sudden pressure drop. Gripping on curbs is ensured by a nylon shoe and two polyurethane rollers, ensuring gentle lifting without scratches or damage to materials. The clamp can lift curbs widthwise, allowing for direct placement during installation. This accessory has significantly improved and sped up curb laying operations, allowing a single operator to lift and place curbs directly on site without the need for additional manual handling. Equipped with scratch-resistant shoes, the clamp jaws protect the integrity of curbs during lifting. This model can be perfectly adapted to earthmoving machines and hydraulic truck cranes. All our clamps are built and tested according to UNI EN 13155, UNI EN ISO 12100, UNI EN 13854, ISO 8686, and UNI EN 10204 standards, and are issued with the appropriate label, certificate of conformity, and user manual. All our products are covered by a one-year warranty (European Directive).
