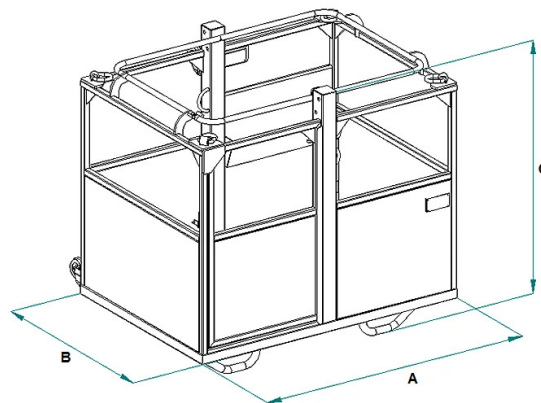

Man-lifting basket without roof
